TEAM COSTS

Each team will be charged \$US1000 per team (US\$250 per player) to help cover expenses such as transportation and meals.

TRANSPORTATION

The Tournament Committee will arrange transportation to and from the airport to the hotel. Transportation will be provided by Cadillac.

The nearest airport is George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH). The golf course is located at the hotel so additional transportation will not be required.

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

For over 20 years, Doug Sanders has sponsored this competition which brings together the top young players from six continents for an annual competition. In 2008 the Championship will be held for the first time in Houston, Texas, having mostly been played in Aberdeen, Scotland. Players from the world's 6 continents will participate. Teams of 4 from each continent, two boys and two girls under the age of 18 as at the 1st January each year and selected by their Golf Body will be accompanied by a coach.

The Championship's goals are to promote and support junior golf, to assist competitors in this International event to win college scholarships to Universities in the United States, to provide need scholarships, to support local charities, and to promote international cooperation.

Acknowledged as the most prestigious and longest running privately funded International Junior Championship in the world, the Doug Sanders Junior International began in 1978.

Stephen Keppler of England won the first Doug Sanders International Junior Championship in 1978. The event has since been won by Steve Elkington (Aust), Andrew Magee (US), Daniel Chopra (Sweden), Adam Scott (Aust) and has seen winners from 10 different countries.

Swedish players have recorded notable success in the Doug Sanders Junior. 1989 winner Gabriel Hjertstedt became the first Swedish player to win 2 US Tour events while Fredrik Jacobson, who won in 1992, has recorded three international victories. 1991 winner Daniel Chopra has had 2 Nationwide victories along with 9 international wins. Chopra also plays the US Tour.

International Player Coordinator - David Healy

David Healy spent 23 years in Australian golf administration where he first met Doug Sanders.

He was responsible for junior programs which introduced Robert Allenby, Brad Hughes, Craig Parry and Stuart Appleby to the game.

He developed one of the worlds first rules accreditation course for rules officials and was recognized as one of the Australia's most knowledgeable rules of golf experts and was a member of the organizing committee for the Australian Open.

Doug and David have maintained a friendship for more than 20 years and David sees the Doug Sanders Junior International Championship as an important vehicle to provide international experience for junior golfers.
